**CABOOLTURE PRIMARY SCHOOLS SUCCESSFUL IN
FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FUNDING ROUND**

Caboolture area Primary Schools have received \$ million in Round 2 of the Federal Government's *Primary Schools for the 21st Century* infrastructure funding initiative.

Announcing the successful schools, Federal Member for Longman Jon Sullivan said that the total for Longman schools in this funding round was nearly \$46 million.

The successful Caboolture Schools are –

- Minimbah State School - \$3 million
- Morayfield State School - \$3 million
- St. Michael's College - \$2.5 million
- St Paul's Lutheran Primary School - \$2.5 million
- St. Peter's School - \$3 million
- Tullawong State School - \$3 million

The funding will be used principally for new halls and libraries, with a portion being spent on new classrooms and learning areas.

Mr. Sullivan said that this investment in schools will benefit our children's quality of education and better equip them to deal with the challenges of the future.

"I am proud to be part of a Government that places such a high priority on education and education infrastructure," Mr Sullivan said.

"Without it our children's futures, and the future of our nation, would be very bleak indeed."

"The projects that this funding will enable to be constructed will mean support for local jobs and increased spending in our retail and service sectors helping to cushion us from the worst of the Global Financial Crisis."
